NOTICE TO SALTWATER FISHERMEN

Effective June 15, 2009: A Saltwater Fishing License is Required to FISH IN MARINE WATERS of Connecticut for anyone 16 years of age or older FISHING FROM SHORE OR FROM A PRIVATE VESSEL.

For Anglers Between 16 and 64 Years of Age, the Fee is \$10 (\$15 for Non-Residents). There is No Fee for Anglers Age 65 and Older. However, an Annual Saltwater Fishing License is Required.

State "Gaffs" Fishing for Revenue

State of Connecticut officials started charging \$10 each for a new saltwater fishing license that does not exist until it is signed into law by Governor Rell. 2,800 licenses were sold before the DEP realized its error and stopped the sales. Now the DEP is waiting for Rell to decide whether to sign the bill before it refunds the money that anglers have already paid for licenses. The decision might take a couple of weeks and at the time of this writing, has not arrived on the Governor's desk. The bill, passed June 3rd, is in response to the Federal government's "imposing" new requirements forming a "fishing registry" which will net Connecticut an estimated \$1 million a year.

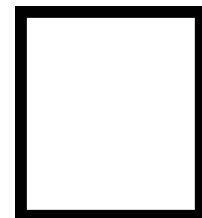
